On behalf of Rainbow Acres and Sedona Lago Gardens, we wish to express our deepest appreciation to Mr. Wagner, Barbara Lago, the donors, supporters and the SLG Board for their good work in serving adults with autism over the past few years.

Mike Prochelo, President & CEO stated, “After considerable effort, the brand that was originally intended to operate with a base in the Sedona community, will cease to operate. Rainbow Acres will be refocusing its efforts on serving people that are neuro-divergent from our main Camp Verde Ranch. The mission of Rainbow Acres is to be a Christian community with heart that empowers people with developmental disabilities to live to their fullest potential with dignity and purpose.

As part of this added focus, Rainbow Acres will be strengthening its programs, partnerships, and resources to continue to serve the autism community in the Verde Valley. Rainbow will be spending more time in Sedona and will invite people to learn more about its overall mission and vision.
